- Complete creative revisions required as called by the Director or Client
- Ensure that all internal and external deadlines are met for the entire Animation department
- Resolve problems or concerns within the Animation department in a productive and positive manner, escalating challenges when necessary

- 2 + years of previous experience as an Animation Supervisor on a production series
- Proficient in the use of Harmony, with a strong understanding of the technical aspects
- Able to manage and mentor a team of 5-10 animators (depending on the production)
- Strong knowledge of animation principles and able to apply them
- Solid understanding of walk cycles, lip sync, and character timing
- Ability to work flexible hours if and when necessary
- Effective problem solving skills, solution oriented
- Ability to work in a collaborative environment and take direction
- Strong attention to detail
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to work under pressure with tight deadlines
