- Review the master design packages, scripts and lists and creates the visuals for the team, ensuring that reuses are used when available
- Reads the scripts to ensure continuity and clarity of each design (character and prop)
- Creates the visual blue print for the entire episode and show, setting the design style and direction for both the STBD and design teams to follow, ensuring that the quality and style of the show remain consistent
- Ensures all roughed character, location and prop designs per episode are delivered on schedule
- Makes any changes or revisions called for and re-submits for Director approval
- Ensures effective communication with the Director and client at all time to ensure that their vision is communicated through the designs
- Asks appropriate guided questions to extract needed information from Director and Clients minimizing the need for revisions to be made

- Able to draw on model and style and bring fresh ideas into the production
- Able to take information shared from Director, clients and script and create the shows style through design of key characters/props/layouts and contribute to this process
- Able to follow proper design fundamentals in both layout and character/prop

- Able to adapt creative style, allowing for successful performance on different shows
- Strong time-management skills, works quickly and meets or exceeds all deadlines
- Understands the entire production pipeline and designs with all steps taken into consideration
